

PAIN CONTROL

Tylenol = Acetaminophen = Q-pap

Motrin = Ibuprofen = Advil

Lortab = Norco = Hydrocodone/Acetaminophen

○ **ALTERNATING TYLENOL AND MOTRIN**

Tylenol	6:00pm

Tylenol	12:00am		

If you have been given Lortab and you or your child's pain is not controlled by Tylenol and Motrin, you can use Lortab as a substitute for Tylenol, but NOT in addition to Tylenol

○ **ALTERNATING LORTAB AND MOTRIN- to be given as needed for pain**

*While taking Lortab, you need to closely observe your child/adult for

- Shallow breathing or changes in normal breathing
- Confusion or altered mental status
